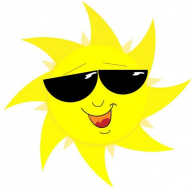


2019 High School Summer School

SCHOOL ENTRANCE FOR SUMMER SCHOOL

All students must enter through either **Door 24** (Fitness Center) or **Door 29** (Totem Pole/Tree of Life). Please be aware that the majority of the **First floor North hallway will be under construction** so all students will have to use the stairwell in the "T" and/or stairwell 16 to get to the summer school classrooms. Students may not enter the building before 7:45 am.

SUMMER SCHOOL COURSES

Most of the summer school courses will be completed through a credit recovery system, to include: English 1-4, U.S. History, World History, Government, Physical Science, Biology. Students will complete/correct the work they did not complete during the semester. They must work to the minimum of a C grade. These students may not have to attend the entire summer school session. They may work on multiple classes and are finished with summer school when they have completed the expectations for the classes needed.

Geometry will be split into two sessions. Students with a failing grade in T1 or T3 will attend June 24-July 11 and students with a failing grade in T2 or T4 will attend July 15-July 31. Some students may need to attend both sessions.

Algebra and Physical Education will require the students to attend the entire 6 week summer school session.

A few courses, will be completed through the summer school ILC, which is computer based. These students also may not have to attend the entire session and will be released from summer school upon completion of their expected course(s).

New for 2019

Planning Your Future will be offered as a class. Students can take it to recover a failing grade or for the first time to free up space in their schedule.
