(classes are normally held Monday through Thursday.
NO classes July 4th or 5th)

(Door 29 - "Totem Pole")

The main purpose of elementary summer school is to help students improve their skills in core subjects of reading, writing and mathematics. Core classes are offered both for the student who needs developmental help, as well as for the student who is progressing at a satisfactory level but wishes to improve their core skills.

If you are not recommended for core classes, a number of enrichment courses are being offered to students. Enrichment courses are designed to expand learning experiences as well as to make learning fun over the summer. Course descriptions and detailed information is attached.

New this year, there are no fees for summer school. Registration is open from March 26th through May 4th. Please send completed forms, along with your recommendation sheet, to your elementary school office ON or after Monday, March 26th. Registrations will not be accepted before the 26th.

Music classes: 4th & 5th grade students who plan to take an instrument-based course, please refer to the music section of your registration packet.

We reserve the right to cancel classes, if needed. We will contact you to adjust schedules as necessary if this occurs with a course your child has already registered to take.
