Dear Parent/Guardian and Students,

It may be hard to believe, but summer vacation is rapidly coming to a close. We are planning for a smooth and efficient start of the new school year. All students must register each year. A walk-in registration for the 2015 - 2016 elementary school year will be held on:

WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 10th (11:00 – 6:00 p.m.)
TUESDAY, AUGUST 16th (8:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.)

Parents are to register their child(ren) at Rawson School. Please bring the child(ren) with you to registration so they can have their school and yearbook pictures taken. **If you are pre-registered you and your child(ren) still need to attend registration during the above times to have the child(rens) pictures taken for School ID and yearbook and to take care of school fees, and make lunch/nutrition break deposits if you have not done so already.**

If your child attended Rawson School in 2015 - 2016, or you pre-registered, you will find enclosed a Student Profile. Please make any corrections in **RED** and complete the information on the second page.

All new families must be registered. Please bring along a record of immunization (immunizations given in Wisconsin can be accessed on line at www.dhs.wisconsin.gov), birth certificate and a current bill(land line phone, tax/rent receipt, utility/cable) showing proof of residency to registration. If you do not have an official birth certificate, please obtain one before registration. They can be ordered from the County Office where your child was born, or from www.vitalchek.com/express-birth-certificats.aspx.

The following fees will be collected at registration:

4 Year Old Kindergarten School Fees	Full year \$30.00
5K - Grade 5 School Fees	Full year \$50.00
5K - vinyl rest mat (required)	\$12.00

School fees and mat fees must be paid with cash or a check made payable to the **School District of South Milwaukee (SDSM)**. You may include all siblings on one check. You will need an additional check for each child if you are ordering school pictures (see enclosed photo envelope).

Breakfast and lunch information from the Food Services Department is also included in this mailing, along with information and an application for free/reduced meals. If you were approved for free/reduced meals last year, you will need to reapply for this school year.

For your convenience, deposits into your child's meal account will be collected at registration. Additionally, the on-line payment system at myschoolbucks.com is an easy, safe way to make account pay-ins and check on your students account status. You will need your child's ID number which can be found on the enclosed Student Profile.
